

Sandstone Special Steam Events 2016, Walking Tours & Other Things To Do At Sandstone

The Sandstone Heritage Trust collection ranges from the smallest industrial locomotives to the giants of South African Railways narrow gauge. To accommodate the collection, of which 22 locomotives are in working order together with nearly 100 items of rolling stock, a 2ft narrow gauge line was constructed on Sandstone Estates farm in 1999 from Mooihoek to Grootdraai followed by extensions in 2002 to Vailima and in 2004 to Vailima Halt and to form a balloon at Pandora Junction. The central point is Hoekfontein where the main station is situated together with the loco depot and workshops. The running line is now nearly 16kms end to end with a 26km round trip journey from start to finish at Hoekfontein. The line is well known throughout the world for its scenery and fearsome gradients and is a photographer's paradise.

Today Sandstone is a centre of excellence in 2ft narrow gauge railways with the largest private collection in the world. It is a magnet to local and overseas visitors and enthusiasts who head to the Eastern Free State for the Sandstone experience. The annual Stars of Sandstone festival is a highlight of the heritage world having been held annually since 2013. The next event will be held from March 29th to 9th April 2017 and will feature the launch of Class NGG11 Garratt locomotive No: 52, the oldest surviving Garratt locomotive in South Africa and the second oldest in the world.

Sandstone operates two routes for train trips.


The Lesotho Meander




